Five Ws (and an H) To Consider When Setting Up — A P2P Event —

Who?

Keep the focus on your participants! It's not about your organization, it's all about your supporters and why they're attending your event.

When?

Take your participants' comfort into consideration and think about when you're hosting an event. The middle of a July day in Florida is probably not the best time to host a walk-a-thon or 5K.

Why?

People are participating in your event for a reason, so figure out what it is and give them what they need — it may be as simple as an opportunity to share their stories!

What?

What can people do to get further involved with your organization? Set up a table with information on volunteering and other ways to get involved.

Where?

Be inclusive when choosing a location is your venue easy to find? Is it accessible for people who may have mobility issues? Have you made it possible for them to participate easily?

How?

Make it clear how your event serves the community. You're often providing a safe place for people to come together and talk about their connection to your cause.

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
