How To "Get" Grants

- A grant is a sum of money given by an organization or government agency for a particular purpose
- A grant is awarded (won) as a result of a grant proposal (also referred to as an application)
- Competitive application process and only eligible organizations can apply
- Application process, deadlines, requirements, and eligibility is determined by "who" is giving the grant



Connect the dots between your community's needs, your nonprofit's mission, and the funder's interests










Free Places To Find Grants


- 1. Industry Email Newsletters

- Personal passions
- A way to implement public policy
- Publicity

It's All About The Right Fit

- Priorities Align: goals, values, priorities and motivations
- Expectations Align: geographic location, population/community served, topic area
- On the same page: type of grant and use of funding
- Timeline: deadlines and award dates fit with your program and/or project schedule

TIP: grants are a partnership between you and the funder

Lesa-Kaye Search Tips

- If it's not scheduled, it won't happen
- Be clear on what you are looking for
- Let your keywords be your guide but also try different combinations and variations
- Start with very narrow search
- Adjust and be more flexible, if you don't get the results that you want
- Stick to your non-negotiables and values
